



30 Scriptures to Strengthen Your Confidence in **God's Grace**

God's grace isn't something to fear or cautiously balance—it's God's way of inspiring you from the inside out.

The following verses reveal what He has already done in you through Jesus: giving you a new heart, freeing you from the power of sin, and equipping you to live in the joy and confidence of His finished work. As you read, let these Scriptures reassure you of His unconditional love, His presence in you, and the freedom you now enjoy under grace thanks to the finished work of Christ.

THEME 1: FREEDOM FROM THE POWER OF SIN

Romans 6:14—Key Truth: You are not a slave to sin.

For sin will have no dominion over you, since you are not under law but under grace.

Titus 2:11–12—Key Truth: Grace trains you from within.

For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation for all people, training us to renounce ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives in the present age...

Romans 6:6—Key Truth: Your old self was crucified with Christ.

Knowing this, that our old self was crucified with Him, in order that our body of sin might be done away with, so that we would no longer be slaves to sin.

Galatians 5:1—Key Truth: Jesus set you free—so live free.

It was for freedom that Christ set us free; therefore keep standing firm and do not be subject again to a yoke of slavery.

Romans 8:9—Key Truth: You are in the Spirit, not the flesh.

However, you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. But if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Him.

THEME 2: YOUR NEW IDENTITY IN CHRIST

2 Corinthians 5:17—Key Truth: You are a new creation.

Therefore if anyone is in Christ, this person is a new creation; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come.

Ezekiel 36:26—Key Truth: God gave you a new heart and new spirit. *Moreover, I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; and I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh.*

1 Corinthians 6:17—Key Truth: You are united with Jesus, one spirit with Him. *But the one who joins himself to the Lord is one spirit with Him.*

Romans 8:15—Key Truth: You are God's beloved child.

For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again, but you have received a spirit of adoption as sons and daughters, by which we cry out, "Abba! Father!"

Colossians 2:9–10—Key Truth: You are complete in Christ.

For in Him all the fullness of Deity dwells in bodily form, and in Him you have been made complete, and He is the head over every ruler and authority.

THEME 3: GOD'S UNCONDITIONAL FORGIVENESS AND ACCEPTANCE

Romans 8:1—Key Truth: You are completely free from condemnation.

Therefore there is now no condemnation at all for those who are in Christ Jesus.

Ephesians 1:7—Key Truth: You are fully forgiven by grace.

In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our wrongdoings, according to the riches of His grace...

Colossians 2:13–14—Key Truth: All your sins were forgiven

at the cross. *When you were dead in your wrongdoings and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He made you alive together with Him, having forgiven us all our wrongdoings, having canceled out the certificate of debt consisting of decrees against us, which was hostile to us; and He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross.*

Hebrews 10:14—Key Truth: Jesus perfected you forever.

For by one offering He has perfected for all time those who are sanctified.

Colossians 1:22—Key Truth: You stand holy and blameless before

God. *Yet He has now reconciled you in His body of flesh through death, in order to present you before Him holy and blameless and beyond reproach—*

THEME 4: GRACE, NOT LAW

Romans 11:6—Key Truth: Grace and works cannot mix.

But if it is by grace, it is no longer on the basis of works; otherwise grace is no longer grace.

Galatians 3:3—Key Truth: You grow the same way you began—by grace. *Are you so foolish? Having begun by the Spirit, are you now being perfected by the flesh?*

Galatians 5:18—Key Truth: Led by the Spirit means free from the law. *But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.*

Romans 5:1-2—Key Truth: You stand securely in grace.

Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we also have obtained our introduction by faith into this grace in which we stand; and we celebrate in hope of the glory of God.

John 1:17—Key Truth: Grace and truth come through Jesus alone.

For the Law was given through Moses; grace and truth were realized through Jesus Christ.

THEME 5: GOD'S KINDNESS, PRESENCE & POWER IN YOU

2 Corinthians 12:9—Key Truth: God's grace is enough for every weakness. *And He has said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for power is perfected in weakness" Most gladly, therefore, I will rather boast about my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may dwell in me.*

Hebrews 4:16—Key Truth: You can approach God boldly.

Therefore let's approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace for help at the time of our need.

Ephesians 3:12—Key Truth: You have bold access to God.

In whom we have boldness and confident access through faith in Him.

2 Timothy 1:9—Key Truth: God saved you by His purpose and grace, not performance. *Who saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was granted to us in Christ Jesus from all eternity...*

1 Peter 5:10—Key Truth: God personally strengthens you. *After you have suffered for a little while, the God of all grace, who called you to His eternal glory in Christ, will Himself perfect, confirm, strengthen, and establish you.*

THEME 6: GRACE AS THE SOURCE OF INSPIRATION

Romans 5:17—Key Truth: God's grace empowers you to reign in life. *For if by the offense of the one, death reigned through the one, much more will those who receive the abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.*

John 1:16—Key Truth: You receive more than enough grace. *For of His fullness we have all received, and grace upon grace.*

Ephesians 2:8–9—Key Truth: Your salvation is a gift of God's grace. *For by grace you have been saved through faith; and this is not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; not a result of works, so that no one may boast.*

2 Peter 3:18—Key Truth: Growing means growing in grace. *But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him be the glory, both now and to the day of eternity. Amen.*
